



Policy on Enrolment

This Enrolment Policy commences for enrolment into First Year 2017/18 and replaces all previous enrolment policies.

The closing date for receipt of applications for First Year is the second Friday in October prior to year of entry.

Skerries Community College has three criteria for enrolment:

1. Designated Feeder Schools:

- St. Patrick's Senior National School, Skerries, Co. Dublin
- Scoil Realt na Mara, Skerries Co. Dublin
- Scoil Mobhi, Milverton, Skerries, Co. Dublin
- Holmpatrick National School, Skerries, Co. Dublin
- St. Brendan's National School, Loughshinny, Co. Dublin
- Skerries Educate Together N. S., Skerries, Co. Dublin

2. Catchment Area—see map overleaf.

3. Sibling of recent past or present student of the College.

Category 1

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who qualify under **all three** of the Criteria listed above.

Category 2

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who qualify under **any two** of the Criteria listed above.

Category 3

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who qualify under **any one** of the Criteria listed above.

Category 4

All other applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form and who do not qualify under any of the three categories listed above.

Lottery

A maximum of 180 applicants can be accommodated in First year. Where the number of applicants in any category is sufficient to exceed the maximum number of places available in the College a lottery will be held for all the applicants in that category. The Lottery will then process the students in the remaining categories.

The lottery will be held in public and supervised by independent parties. A waiting list will be drawn up from the unsuccessful applicants in the order as they came in the lottery draw. This waiting list will remain in place until the first day of the academic year in the year of entry.
